

## Geoeconomics of Irregular Warfare: Iran and the Global Ripple Effects â?? Part VII

### Description

In Part Seven of Irregular Warfare Initiativeâ??s series on the Iran conflict, produced by IWIâ??s Economic & Legal Warfare team, the focus turns to how escalation is being applied across economic, legal, and cognitive domains. The discussion features an expert panel including, [Gianni Koskinas](#) (CEO, Hoplite Group), [Hamlet Yousef](#) (IWI Economic & Legal Warfare Advisor), and [Matt Flug](#) (Director, Economic & Legal Warfare Focus Area, IWI), moderated by Jackie Giunta of Irregular Warfare Initiativeâ??s Engagements team.

As the conflict enters its eighth week, the panel examines how maritime enforcement, asset seizures, and pressure on energy and financial systems are producing cascading effects across the region and beyond. With particular attention to the Strait of Hormuz and Iranâ??s asymmetric use of infrastructure and proxy networks, the discussion highlights how disruption and uncertainty are being used to impose cost. This session provides a clear lens on how escalation is unfoldingâ??and where it may lead next.
